All attached descriptions should be carefully read and inspected prior to bidding. All descriptions and quantities are believed to be accurate at the time of posting. The Wayne County Board of Education will not be responsible for description errors or omissions. It is the bidder's responsibility to inspect all items prior to bidding. All equipment will be sold "AS IS" and "WHERE IS" with no warranty expressed or implied.

The outside of the sealed bid envelope must be clearly marked with equipment name and serial number. The Wayne County Board of Education reserves the right to reject any and all bids or parts of bids. Payment will be due at the time of pick-up. All successful/winning bidders will be notified within two-day business days of bid closing and will have fourteen days to pay and pick-up items. The winning bidder will not be allowed to sort or leave partial items behind. Each individual lot will be sold to the highest bidder. Bidders may bid on one or more lots as desired but must be bid in separate envelopes.

The deadline for sealed bids will be 2:00 pm (EST) on December 16th, 2025 at which time they will be publicly opened in the Board Room of the Wayne County Board of Education located at 150 Cardinal Way Monticello, KY 42633. Bids may be hand delivered or mailed. Wayne County Board of Education is not responsible for bids lost or delayed in the mail.
