



Waxahachie Lady Indians Volleyball Booster Club Scholarship Program

The Waxahachie Lady Indians Volleyball Booster Club (WVBC) will award 3 \$1000 scholarships for the 2025-2026 school year.

Purpose: To support and encourage WHS volleyball athletes who choose to pursue higher education and to recognize student athletes who demonstrate character traits such as leadership, sportsmanship, accountability, integrity, strong work ethic, responsibility, and perseverance.

Application Instructions

1. Complete the WVBC scholarship application and submit all required documentation.
 - a. Pick up the WVBC Scholarship application in the WHS volleyball office or print the application from the WHS scholarship webpage.
 - b. Submit the completed application and supporting documents by March 28, 2026. No late applications will be accepted.
2. All requirements must be met, and the application must be complete to be considered.
3. Submit the application form and attachments in a sealed envelope to Coach Gonzales or the WVBC president, Elizabeth Robinson. You may also submit to waxvballboosterclub@gmail.com. Complete applications will be given to the WVBC Scholarship Selection Committee for review.
4. Applicants will be contacted to schedule an interview with the WVBC Scholarship Selection Committee.
5. The WVBC Scholarship Selection Committee will consider the application, supporting documents, and the interview to select recipients.

WVBC Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

1. High school GPA of 3.0 or higher. Provide a current transcript that includes the fall semester of senior year.
2. Provide SAT and/or ACT scores.
3. Qualified for a letter as a senior and demonstrated leadership.
4. No UIL contract violations during junior or senior year.
5. Supply proof of acceptance to an accredited college, university, trade school, or institute.
6. Submit two letters of recommendation:
 - a. From a member of the community, not WISD affiliated.
 - b. From a WHS faculty member excluding coaches.
7. Applicants will be contacted to schedule an interview with the WVBC Scholarship Selection Committee.

Scholarship Appropriations

1. Applicant must provide proof of acceptance or enrollment in a community college, 4-year college or university, or trade school for the fall semester of 2026.
2. A check made payable to the recipient will be presented to the recipient at the WHS Scholarship Program.

WVBC Scholarship Guidelines

1. The WVBC Board will identify and invite five individuals to serve on the WVBC Scholarship Selection Committee by the end of January 2026.
 - a. One member will be a current WVBC member in good standing with the club. This member cannot have a player eligible for the scholarship.
 - b. Other members will be community members with no connection to current senior volleyball athletes.
 - c. The WVBC president will appoint one member as chair of the committee.
 - d. The committee will be reappointed every year.
 - e. Parents or guardians of scholarship applicants are not allowed to participate on the WVBC Scholarship Selection Committee.
2. The WVBC Scholarship Selection Committee will select scholarship recipients by April 4, 2026.
3. The WVBC is responsible for raising funds and establishing the scholarship budget each year.
4. The WVBC will distribute scholarship funds to recipients at the WHS Scholarship Program.
