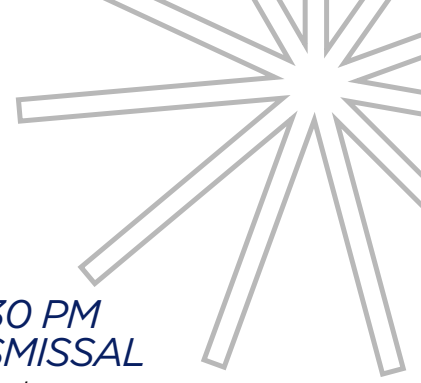

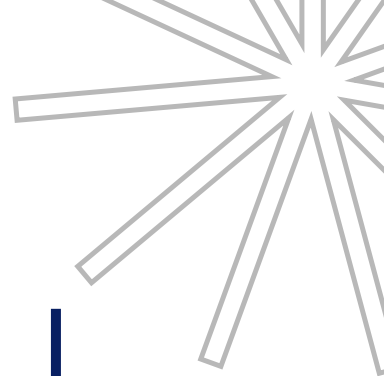

# FINANCIAL AID

St. Paul's understands that an independent school education is a major investment for families to consider, and we are committed to supporting students who need tuition assistance.

The Financial Aid process runs separately from the student admissions process. Parents will complete a financial aid application through Clarity. Please note that the application fee for Clarity is \$60. Upon St. Paul's acceptance of a student, the recommended financial aid award is applied to the enrollment contract for parents to review.

Financial Aid applications are due by December 1 for priority consideration but can be submitted any time during the rolling admissions process.
