Our School Dress Code

All children attending St Andrews Samakee are expected to wear school uniform, which is available at the Samakee Shop.

St. Andrews has a 'no shoes policy' in the school buildings and we expect our children, teachers and visitors to abide by this. This policy is for two reasons – hygiene and protection of the floors and carpets. We suggest shoes that are appropriate for running, climbing and active play and should be easy for children to put on and off (**thongs, flip flops, Crocs or slippers are not allowed**).

Sports Kit:

All children must wear the sports kit appropriate to their sport.

Sun Hats:

All children must wear the uniform legionnaires hat when doing outdoor activities.

School Shoes:

Footwear must be safe and sensible. Shoes should be easily fastened and offer support to the foot when the child is running or climbing during playtime. **No flip-flops, Crocs or high-heeled shoes** should be worn to school. Trainers are required for P.E. sessions. We operate a 'shoes off' policy in the school buildings.

Book Bag:

All children need a book bag that is designed to keep reading/library books, homework and letters to parents. (not required for KS3)

Water Flask:

A water bottle should be brought to school daily to prevent dehydration. Bottles may be refilled at the water dispensers, available in convenient areas around the school.

Identification:

All clothing must be marked clearly with the child's name in indelible ink on the labels provided. Footwear must be marked in indelible ink or tapes.

Children must observe the following guidelines:

- Children must wear the uniform appropriate to their year group.
- Children must wear their uniform when participating in school trips and on any occasion when they are representing the School.
- No coloured T-shirts or T-shirts that are visible at the collar or sleeves may be worn under uniforms; a white vest may be worn under shirts and dresses if required.
- No coloured leggings or trousers that are visible under dresses may be worn, white cycling shorts or girls boxer shorts may be worn but should not be visible below dresses.
- Clothes must be smart, clean and well cared for.
- No jewellery to be worn other than for medical or religious reasons. For children with pierced ears, only appropriate small stud earrings may be worn.
- Watches may be worn, providing they are not bulky on the child's wrist.
- Hairstyles to be neat and tidy, with natural colouring. Long hair must be tied back for PE and swimming.
- No make up, nail varnish or other fashion accessories to be worn.
