- Staff Updates -
 - We currently have a total of 68 staff members, with 24 new to Felty this year (35% of our team). Five staff members were hired before summer, and thirteen more joined between summer and now, for a total of eighteen new hires during the hiring window. We also had two internal transfers (Para and Security), two new SPED positions added (SLPA and VI), three internal role changes, and three grade level shifts. Our remaining openings are an SLE Aide and a Principal Secretary.
- Campus Background -
 - Felty continues to support multiple specialized programs, including three SPED units with VI services. With shifts in staffing, class sizes in the primary grades increased moderately after absorbing positions. Our campus has had transfers from last school year, including students who demonstrated strong academic performance on STAAR. Demographic and campus data show an increase in students identified as economically disadvantaged, improved attendance, and an increase in discipline needs compared to last year. Our SPED population remains a significant portion of the campus, and we currently have students receiving homebound services.

 - We reviewed our current STAAR performance and the 2023–2025 scale

score goals to ensure alignment with our campus targets. We also examined current unit assessment data to identify trends that will guide instructional decisions going into 2025–2026. Our plan moving forward includes the use of a campus data tracker, data binders, and ongoing data digs to monitor student growth and adjust instruction as needed. Additionally, we discussed HB 1416/4545 tutoring requirements and noted that we currently have 1,584 hours remaining to complete for students in need of accelerated instruction.
