Good News: Richard Bell, executive director of operations, highlighted the [many accomplishments of Support Services over the summer](#), including custodial, grounds and maintenance departments.

Spotlight on Learning: Traci Holder, assistant superintendent for academic affairs, shared [outcomes of the phonic foundations tutoring program](#) that was offered over the summer of for eligible students entering grades 1, 2 and 3.

Health Insurance: Jeremy Boldra, assistant superintendent for human resources, presented an [update on health insurance renewals](#) for the 2026 year. Average renewal increases are approximately 27.5 percent.

Enrollment and Staffing Report: Boldra presented an [update on staffing and enrollment](#) for the 2025-26 school year. Preliminary enrollment numbers show an increase of 39 students at the elementary level and an increase of 45 students at the secondary level.
