-Next on the calendar for testing will be the TSI. This will be administered tomorrow morning. I have approximately 10 students signed up to take either the entire test or one section or the other (being Math or ELAR)

-We had a visit with Midland College on November 13, 2025. The students were able to meet with them and make sure they are on track to receiving all of the credits they would like to complete before graduating. They are working on updates and will get them to me as soon as possible. They are also working on getting our plan in place to where we are able to tell the students these are the courses that are allowed through the program and our agreement with Midland College.

-Six of our seven graduates have been accepted into multiple colleges. I believe free college application week was a success. Now it is time to make certain they get the FAFSA filed in a timely manner.

-Yesterday we had a presentation for all students in grades 8 - 12. A representative from Big Bend Crisis Center came and spoke to our students on Teen Dating Violence, Bullying, and Suicide. She is hoping to come back and visit with students one on one before the semester is over. They also provided us with a Thanksgiving Gift Basket which was given to a needy family yesterday. Along with this they gave us school supplies which had been donated to the center. They are distributing to the area they cover which includes 5 counties.

Mr. Carrasco reported the Clevertouch board in Mrs. Saddleback's room has been repaired, VGI has repaired the gym door and several others, we have also checked to ensure security cameras are in working order

We already have 60% of our JH students in advanced math and have always pushed our math fact flashcards, we will begin tutoring for STAAR more frequently the closer we get to STAAR

- k. Safety Audit / Safety
 - our three year safety audit was conducted November 12th, we will have minor corrections, but the official report has not been uploaded as of year for our review
 - On Monday November 17th I met with our community safety partners including: Sheriff's Department, Border Patrol, DPS, State Emergency management, Volunteer Fire Department and EMS to go over our School Safety Plan of action and safety measures including: Guardian Program, exterior key boxes, ballistic tools, ballistic film, door locks, security video monitoring, CPR / Stop the Bleed / Narcan locations, staff phone numbers, code words, safety drills and future requirements of the BTA.
 - BTA meetings - I attended two Behavioral Threat Assessment training sessions in Del Rio this month.
 - Our guardians had firearm practice during our workday on November 3.
 - Nurse V and our local EMS trained our staff in CPR and Stop the Bleed during our workday on November 3.
- l. Special Education Audit
 - minor findings, corrected. We are still waiting for our official findings. Everything looks to be on track for a clean audit.
- m. TIA Update
 - I have attended several more training sessions and we are on track for official data validation next year. Teachers have completed BOY benchmarks and we are relearning our data platform (Eduphoria) with another staff training in December.
- n. The playground fence will be completed by December 10th and everything is going well.
- o. The science lab and entry floors will be completed during Thanksgiving break
 - Our enrollment is 109. We have started our 3 year Special Education Audit and will have our 3 year safety audit in November with Region 18. Homecoming, shot clinic and see you at the pole went well. Report cards for the first six weeks went out along with A-F letters, gun storage letters, and fentanyl awareness letters. Eduphoria is ready for TIA benchmarking. Teacherworkday on Monday went well.
