- ❖ If you are awarded a scholarship, it is **MANDATORY** that you attend the senior awards ceremony on **April 29, 2026**. You will be notified in advance if you are a recipient of any scholarships, so you are able to make arrangements to attend the ceremony.

Instructions for submitting each application:

Please read each scholarship carefully as they may have different requirements.

The packet is located online (Dawson Counseling Center) as a fillable document if you want to complete it on the computer and print.

1. Complete pages 2 & 3. Make copies of the personal information and student profile page (pages 2 and 3) and attach it to **each** application that requires it. Some applications have their own.
2. The signed scholarship application must be stapled in front of the requested requirements for each application.
3. If the application requests a transcript, go to skyward to print one out. If the application requests an **official transcript**, go to the counseling office or to the webstore to request one. Official transcripts cost \$2.00 each and please allow 2-3 days for processing.
4. Each scholarship application must be put in a **separate** manila envelope. Put your full name and the name of the scholarship on the front of each envelope. Please write neatly. Do not submit paper copies for online applications.
5. Page 4 needs to be turned in when you turn in all the scholarship applications in the manila envelopes. Follow the directions on page 4. Must be signed by Ms. Merritt or Ms. Rizqi
6. Once completed, turn into the **Counseling office no later than February 12th at 2:35pm.**

Application Deadline: February 12, 2026, by 2:35 pm

Applications will not be accepted after this date and time. NO exceptions.

The counseling team will not be responsible for checking if you have all your documents. Please make sure to double-check all requirements before submitting.

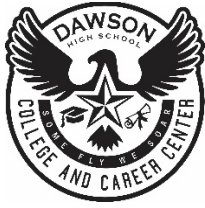

SCHOLARSHIP

- I. The Scholarship Committee of Brazoria-Galveston County Farm Bureau will select an individual to receive a \$4,000 scholarship.
- II. To be eligible to receive the scholarship, an applicant must:
- a. Be a graduating high school senior from a Brazoria or Galveston County high school, a Clear Creek ISD high school or a home school student residing in Brazoria or Galveston County.
 - b. Turn in completed application form accompanied by a high school transcript, SAT and/or ACT test results (if applicable) and three (3) letters of reference.
 - c. Plan to attend a college, technical or trade school and take a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester. (Will be required to provide proof of registration.)
 - d. Be the son or daughter of a current **Brazoria-Galveston County Farm Bureau** member. If awarded, parents must maintain membership for the duration of the scholarship.
 - e. Submit application no later than March 23, 2026.
- III. The money will be paid directly to the college/school as follows:
- 1st Year-** \$500 the fall semester upon proof of registration for a minimum of 12 credit hours. \$500 the spring semester, upon proof of registration for a minimum of 12 credit hours and a minimum **2.0** GPA maintained the preceding semester.
- 2nd Year-** \$500 the fall semester and \$500 the spring semester with registration for 12 credit hours minimum and minimum **2.0** GPA the preceding semester.
- 3rd Year-** \$500 the fall semester and \$500 the spring semester with registration for 12 credit hours minimum and minimum **2.0** GPA the preceding semester.
- 4th Year-** \$500 the fall semester and \$500 the spring semester with registration for 12 credit hours minimum and a minimum **2.0** GPA the preceding semester.
- Scholarship stops if at any time the requirements for a semester are not met.*

Requirements: Please be sure to include all the information and documents requested below in a sealed envelope with the senior's name and "Dawson PTA Scholarship" legibly written or printed on the outside of the envelope. Incomplete applications will be disqualified.

1. Read and sign this application and include the signed application form.
2. Provide a current transcript.
3. Provide both Personal History Profile Pages.
4. Provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher or school administrator.
(Provider may not be related to student.)
5. Provide completed Dawson PTA's 2026 Senior Scholarship Qualification Form
6. Provide a one-page typed essay on the following topic:

"Describe how you have demonstrated community involvement both in and out of school."

7. Provide a half page minimum to one-page maximum typed essay on the following topic:

"How did the PTA positively affect your school career?"

- Both essays must be typed, double spaced, size 12 Times New Roman font.
- Provide a word count at the end of both essays.
- Do not include your name on the essay. Instead, use your PISD Student ID number.
- Completed essays must be in a sealed envelope with the student's name and student ID number, and included with the completed Dawson PTA scholarship application packet.

Gulf Coast Educators Federal Credit Union (GCEFCU) is pleased to announce the new application portal for our scholarships. The application portal is through Smarter Select.com. The link will access our application portal at <https://smr.to/p104823>

Gulf Coast Educators Federal Credit Union offers a notable scholarship opportunity, presenting up to four scholarships annually. Each scholarship is valued at \$1,000 per semester and is renewable for four years, bringing the total award amount to \$8,000 per recipient.

Of the four scholarships available each year, two are designated for students who intend to pursue a course of study that prepares them for a career in teaching. The remaining two scholarships may be awarded to applicants who are pursuing fields outside of education. It is important to note that the scholarship committee retains the discretion to award scholarships based solely on the specified areas of consideration. Applicants must be members of the credit union and meet all specified eligibility requirements to be considered for selection.

REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant must be a high school senior.
- Applicant must be a member (or eligible for membership) and in good standing with the credit union.
- Recipients of the scholarship(s) must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 and earn at least 12 hours minimum each semester. A transcript must be received after each semester to show the recipient is within the requirements set forth by the Board. Failure to comply will result in permanent forfeiture.
- The scholarship will be used for the purpose of studying at an accredited college or university.
- Scholarship funds will be paid each semester to the school of the recipient's choice when evidence of enrollment and GPA maintained is presented to the credit union.
- Areas of consideration for selection will include need, academic achievement, character, leadership and personal recommendations.
- A candidate must have a minimum combined SAT score of 1000 and / or a minimum ACT score of 21.
