6th Grade

Students are finishing up the Rube Goldberg projects and made an obstacle course with simple machines. We are moving on to the study of Allies and the Humane Society will join us to discuss the role of therapy and service dogs in people's lives.

5th Grade

Students read quotes from the novel, *Don Quixote* and interpreted them in the context of the novel. We discussed parody vs satire and students looked for examples from the text for each. Students will learn and engage in a Socratic Seminar this month.

4th Grade

4th graders are studying the rock cycle and erosion and weathering. We examined the impact heat and pressure has on rocks and made a informational booklet to show these processes.

3rd Grade

During a gallery walk each 3rd graders presented their research on birds, fish, amphibians and mammals to their peers. Together all students summarized the original animal classification system on a tree map.
