We are looking forward to the many opportunities to connect with families next week. We hope you will join us for our 2:00 PM Parent Chat on bar models, led by our Math Specialist, Heather Weldon. Ms. Weldon will demystify what bar models are, show how they develop across the grades, and explain how they support the deep conceptual thinking emphasized in the math standards. She will also share how bar models fit within Math in Focus and how they help students move from concrete understanding to abstract problem solving. We hope this session offers clarity and helpful strategies for supporting your child's learning at home.
