MORNING Reggio invitations are a time to play and explore the classroom. During this time, we are invited to do Reggio-inspired, open-ended activities. For Morning Meeting, we all come together and begin our day with the pledge and prayer. After a healthy snack provided by SAGE Dining, we spend time on the playground building friendships, exploring, and using our imaginations.

Some days we have music class, where our teacher encourages us to sing songs, explore instruments, and use our motor skills to dance! We learn foreign languages through song, and create through drawing, painting, and collage. We spend part of our morning learning in the Tinker Lab, a project-based learning program in a STEAM environment, and strengthening our bodies in P.E. We also learn Bible stories throughout the day and at our Family Chapel Services.

MID-MORNING On the playground we run, climb, swing, ride bikes, and play with our friends! We love watching the squirrels, collecting sticks and acorns, and spending time in the learning garden watching caterpillars grow to butterflies, and seeds turn into food. Back in the classroom, we have centers and also get into small groups to focus on our weekly theme within our emergent curriculum. During lunch, SAGE provides delicious meal options for us. We eat family style while learning to use utensils and drink from regular cups.
