Course Description/Goals:

World Geography will include human, physical, economic, and cultural geography. Emphasis will be placed on understanding the impact that environment has on the social, cultural, and economic life of a region. Stressed also will be an examination of uses, abuses, and preservation of natural resources and the physical environment.
