

At the Middle School Level, the New York State Department of Education mandates most of the courses that students take. However, in addition to our academic core program of English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, World Language, and the required programs in Health and Physical Education, we also offer several exploratory experiences. Those courses include Art, Music, Technology, and Family and Consumer Science.

The 8th-grade students should carefully consider the electives they select, as they will not be able to make changes after the requests are locked. When creating a high school schedule, sections are filled, leaving little room for movement. Elective courses should be selected based on student interest as opposed to electives their friends are planning to take.

Prior to the aforementioned dates, please read through the curriculum guide carefully with your 8th grade child, so that together you can create the best possible schedule.
