Students in grades 1-5 use IXL as a resource to support their learning in the classroom. IXL is an online learning platform that is designed to meet each child's individual learning needs in Math and Language Arts. Real-Time Diagnostics help identify knowledge gaps and are then used to create individualized learning plans that adjust to meet each learner's individual needs.

Parents can use IXL at home to:

- Monitor their child's progress by viewing detailed reports on their child's progress, including trouble spots and usage details.
- Support their child's learning by using built-in instructional video tutorials.
- Reinforce learning with their child by reading step by step explanations that help identify where a mistake was made.
- Celebrate their's child's milestones by talking about their "Smart Scores" and viewing their Awards page.
