SCHOLARSHIPS 2024

The MORGAN GREENFIELD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP was added in 2024 through the generosity of Josh Themer and family. Morgan was a 2009 graduate of Bradley Bourbonnais Community High School, as was her late brother, Matthew, in 2010. As a student at BBCHS, Morgan displayed an extraordinary talent in the arts, specifically her ability to draw and paint. Her passion did not end there, as Morgan held an even deeper passion for helping animals and dedicated her life to doing so.

After high school, Morgan attended Fox College in Tinley Park where she studied veterinary technology and shortly thereafter became a licensed vet tech. As a vet tech, Morgan saved many lives and impacted so many more, both humans and animals alike. A \$1,000 scholarship was awarded in 2024.

The NILKANTH BUSINESS SCHOLARSHIP was established by Bhavin Patel, a Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School 2016 graduate. Bhavin was a member of the Robotics team and received a Foundation scholarship while he was a student at BBCHS. His generosity to give back to BBCHS is commendable. In 2024 two \$500 scholarships were awarded.

DR. RAJEEV PURI, a local surgeon, and his wife, DR. NANCY REAU, generously offered a \$1,000 scholarship in 2024. Their intention for the scholarship was to support a BBCHS student with a guardian who is employed as a teacher, or serving the police or fire departments. Their interest in supporting those who serve others in a way that helps support their students is admirable.

COACH DARLA MOLDENHAUER is a retired BBCHS teacher and was a devoted BBCHS physical education teacher and volleyball coach for 30 years. Her goal was to do whatever she could to help her athletes become successful on and off the court and navigate not only high school, but also life. She is a teacher, a coach, a friend, a leader, a mentor, a volunteer and always an advocate for female students and athletes. Four \$1,000 scholarships were awarded in 2024.



CLASS OF 1980

Sue Schierenbeck graduated in 1980 and was a standout three-sport athlete playing Volleyball, Basketball, and Track and Field. Sue earned 12 varsity letters in her four years at BBCHS competing at the varsity level in all three sports as a freshman. Sue is the only female athlete to qualify for an IHSA state tournament series in both an individual and a team sport with a total of 5 state appearances.

CLASS OF 2001

Adam Vogel graduated in 2001 and has contributed to the athletic success of BBCHS as a Football Coach and Head strength coach from 2011-2022. Adam was an all-state football player and a wrestling state qualifier with a record of 38-1 his senior year. Adam attended Indiana State University on a full scholarship to play football where he was a 4 year varsity letterman earning Academic All-Conference two of his four seasons. Adam went on to play 5 seasons professionally.

CLASS OF 2007

Jerrod Gray graduated in 2007 and was a standout athlete in both Football and Track. In track he was a State Qualifier in the Shot and Disc and a two time team MVP in 2006 and 2007. In football, Jerrod was an all-state player that earned a full ride football scholarship at Ball State University where he competed in the International Bowl in 2007 and the GMAC Bowl in 2008.
