



Grades K-8 Dress Code 2026-27

Redlands Christian Schools desires to foster a Christ-like atmosphere that maximizes learning and growth. Uniformed attire helps achieve these goals by reducing unhealthy competition around fashion, decreasing distractions and promoting standards that are consistent with our school values. Uniforms also facilitate a sense of professionalism and unity that make it easier to maintain a safe and secure campus.

Redlands Christian Schools has chosen Lands' End as the uniform provider. All Lands' End shirts and some outerwear are embroidered with the RCS logo. The RCS Preferred School Number is 900208166.

GIRLS

SHIRTS

Shirts must be buttoned. Undergarments may not be visible at any time. Plain camisoles, undershirts, turtlenecks and crew necks without writing or prints may be worn under uniform tops and should not extend below the bottom of the uniform polo shirt. No exposed midriff or lower back – ensure that shirts are purchased in the appropriate size. Modifications are not permitted.

- Lands' End Polo Shirts – white, red or black (multiple styles)

PANTS/SHORTS/SKIRTS/SKORTS

Pants, shorts, skirts or skorts that are excessively tight, baggy, dirty or in disrepair are not allowed. Undergarments may not be visible at any time. No leggings, pajama pants, athletic wear, elastic hems, joggers or jeggings/yoga pants allowed on regular dress code days. No modifications. No rolling or hemming to be outside the standards for the dress code.

- Lands' End Pants – khaki or black (multiple styles)
- Lands' End Shorts – khaki or black (multiple styles)
- Lands' End Skort or Skirt (multiple styles)
- Lands' End Jumper

BOYS

SHIRTS

Shirts must be buttoned. Plain undershirts, turtlenecks or long-sleeve crew neck shirts without writing or prints may be worn under uniform shirts. Modifications are not permitted. Purchase in the appropriate size and fit.

- Lands' End Polo Shirts – white, red or black (multiple styles)

PANTS/SHORTS

Pants or shorts that are excessively tight, baggy, dirty or in disrepair are not allowed. Undergarments may not be visible at any time. No leggings, pajama pants, athletic wear, elastic hems, joggers or jeggings/yoga pants allowed on regular dress code days. No modifications. No rolling or hemming to be outside the standards for the dress code.

- Lands' End Pants – khaki or black (multiple styles)
- Lands' End Shorts – khaki or black (multiple styles)

OUTERWEAR

- Polo shirt must be worn beneath outerwear
- Lands' End outerwear OR Redlands Christian spirit wear
- RCS athletic team outerwear

ACCESSORIES

- Girls can choose appropriate accessories to wear with their uniform (hair bands, hair ribbons)
- RCS baseball caps may be worn indoors, though teachers can make decisions for their own classroom.

JEWELRY, ETC.

Jewelry should not be distracting to others and should be chosen with discretion. Students who have visible body piercing(s) other than a girl's ear piercings or girl's stud nose piercing are required to remove them while on campus and at all school sponsored activities (no matter what the results are to the piercing). Covering piercings with tape or Band-Aids is not sufficient. Visible tattoos are not permitted. No polished fingernails for boys. Choker necklaces of any kind are not permitted.

HAIR

GIRLS

Hair must be a natural hair color and must be kept clean and appropriately styled.

BOYS

Boys' hair must be a natural hair color and must be neat and well groomed. Mohawks are not allowed. Male students with facial hair must keep it trimmed neatly.

SHOES

Shoes must be safe, clean, appropriate for school and not a distraction.

LOWER SCHOOL

Boys: athletic/tennis shoes, rubber sole dress shoes or dress boots, cowboy boots

Girls: athletic/tennis shoes or closed-toe, rubber sole shoes, dress boots, cowboy boots
No slides, slippers, sandals without a back strap.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

-Students are encouraged to wear athletic/tennis shoes.

-Crocs are permitted.

-Boots or cowboy boots are permitted.

-No slides, slippers, sandals without a back strap.

SPECIAL DRESS DAYS

Special dress days and costume/theme days may be announced by the school administration. Students may choose to participate. All attire on these days must be modest and appropriate. Students who choose not to participate in the theme must be in regular school uniform.

SPIRIT FRIDAYS

Every Friday unless otherwise announced, is a spirit-wear Friday. Students can wear jeans or uniform shorts, pants, skorts or skirts with an Eagle themed shirt or a plain red or black t-shirts.

AFTER SCHOOL EVENTS

While we recognize that after-school events may call for either more relaxed or more formal dress, we expect the students to dress appropriately for all occasions associated with the school. Modesty is a priority when it comes to attending any after school activities. At no time shall students wear any article of clothing or accessory that displays an offensive quality or slogan or that does not support the values, rules or philosophy of Redlands Christian Schools.

SWIMSUITS

The following swimwear rules will be enforced: Girls' swimsuits must be a modest one piece or be covered by a dark colored t-shirt/tank top/rash guard to reflect a one-piece. Guys must wear swim shorts (no speedos) that stay above the waist at all times.

DRESS CODE ACCOUNTABILITY

Students are expected to be dressed in keeping with the school uniform. Students not dressed per these guidelines will be sent to the school office until the issue has been resolved. The administration is the final authority in determining and interpreting the dress code. In keeping with our approach to every topic, grace is the order of the day, but repeated dress code violations will be interpreted as a heart issue and dealt with more significantly.
