## **Activities to Build Partnerships**

There are a variety of avenues for parent involvement at Vintage High School ranging from participating in governance on the Advisory Council to supporting academics, music and athletics through our Academic, Music and Athletic Booster Clubs. Parents of second language learners maintain a close relationship through our English Learner Advisory Committee (ELAC) which we call Voces de los Padres. 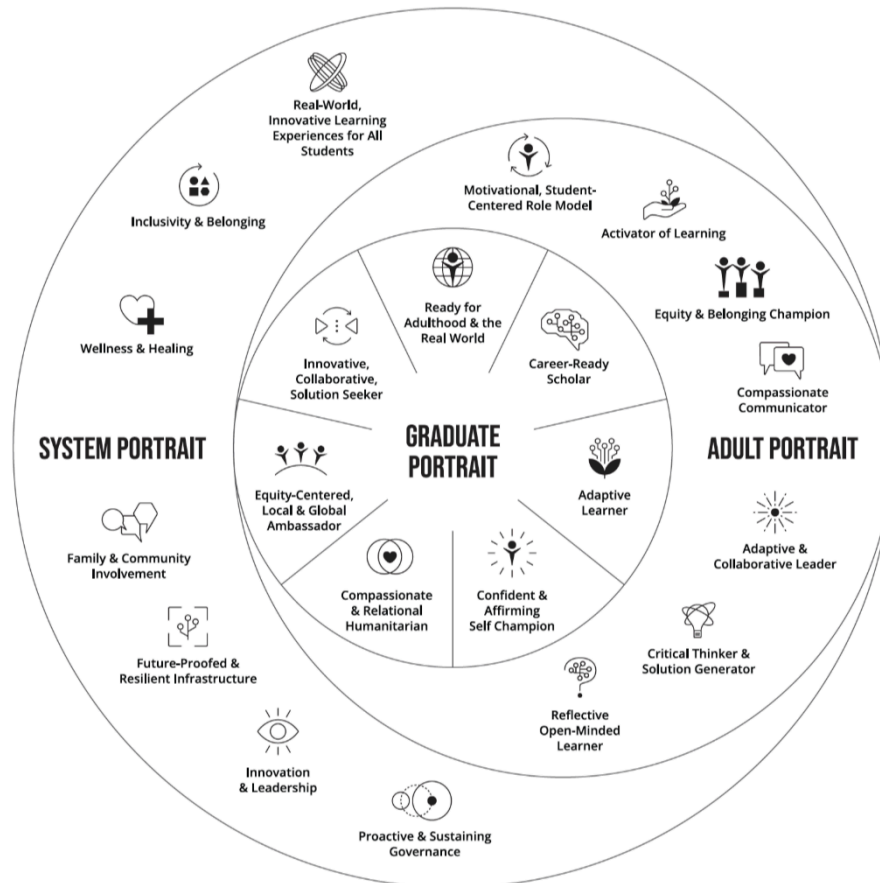

Our **Vision** includes:

To support this **Vision**, a plan was created. ***Transforming Our Future Together*** is our 2024–2029 strategic plan and is the first in a series of multi-year plans outlining the important steps we will take toward realizing Vision 2040. ## **District Mission**
