Dear North Street School:

We are sending you this letter to inform you of a data privacy issue involving your child's report card.

On December 4, it was discovered that in the process of providing specific report card information for one student to the Connecticut State Department of Education, *all* North Street School students' report cards were provided in error, which then in turn, the State shared with one North Street School family. The CSDE has stated that the information has been deleted and that no copies remain. By law, GPS must notify families within two days when an error such as this occurs.

Sec. 10-234dd. Duties re unauthorized release, disclosure or acquisition of student data.

... Upon receipt of notice of a breach of security under subdivision (1) or (2) of this subsection, a local or regional board of education shall electronically notify, not later than two business days after receipt of such notice, the student and the parents or guardians of the student whose student information, student records or student-generated content is involved in such breach of security. The local or regional board of education shall post such notice on the board's Internet web site.

Again, we want to reiterate that the CSDE has stated that the information has been deleted and that no copies remain. This notification is procedural in nature for our families.
