



HIGH SCHOOL Application & Placement Process

YOUR FUTURE STARTS NOW

Every Auburn program enrolls up to 24 students. Any application submitted on or before February 10, 2026, will be considered for initial placement through our randomization process. Our software will randomize applicants and place them into their first-choice until all 24 seats of that program are filled. Once a program reaches capacity, additional applicants will be placed into their second-choice while also remaining on the waitlist for their first-choice program.

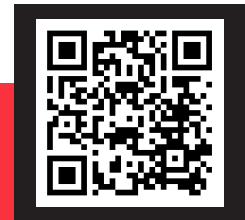
Applicants will be notified of their placement or waitlist status by early March.

Enrollment continues on a rolling basis. As seats open, waitlisted students will be moved into available spots according to their randomized order. After February 10, the Enrollment Team will assist students individually to place them into any remaining open seats.

Open-enrolled students (non-residents from partner districts) will be considered only after all in-district applicants—both 2-year and 1-year students—have been placed. If a seat remains available in a program at that point, an open-enrolled student may be admitted.
