Using a shoelace, sew in and out of the holes in your sewing card. If you don't have a shoelace, you can wrap the end of a piece of yarn or string with tape.

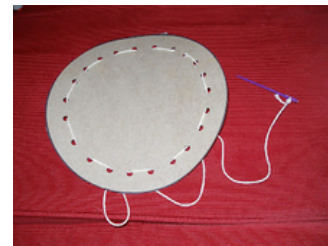
