Fees and Cancellation Policy

Most Community Ed programs are fee-based, as we are self-supporting. Unless otherwise noted, all necessary materials and supplies are included in the registration fee. When possible, online registration is encouraged. If registering by mail, include fees with the registration form. Checks should be made payable to Parkway-Rockwood Community Ed. Returned or late payments are subject to additional fees as determined by Community Ed and can result in removal from the program.

Cancellation of classes/programs will be at the discretion of Community Ed. If a class/program is cancelled due to low enrollment, participants will be notified and receive a full refund. Customer-initiated cancellations made at least three business days prior to start of class or program may qualify for a refund minus a 5% processing fee. Customer-initiated cancellations made two or less business days prior to start of class/program or prior to second meeting of class/program with multiple meeting dates may qualify for a 50% refund. No refunds will be made following the second meeting of class/program. Adventure Club, Early Childhood, Rockwood Thunder Volleyball, Gateway Swim Club and Smoky Mountain Adventures have separate cancellation policies.

Participation Waiver

In exchange for the Parkway-Rockwood Community Education Program sanctioning the Program and providing district-paid staff members or other designees to supervise the Program, I hereby agree as follows:

- I hereby acknowledge that I understand the nature of the Program, and believe that I am qualified and in proper physical condition to participate in the Program. I further agree that if at any time, I believe my participation in the Program is unsafe with respect to my physical condition, the equipment, or facilities, it shall be my responsibility to immediately discontinue my participation in the Program.
- I further acknowledge that I am aware that participation in the Program involves the risk of illness, serious bodily injury (including the possibility of permanent disability, paralysis, or death), which may be caused by (a) my own actions or inactions, (b) the actions or inactions of others participating in the Program, (c) the condition of the equipment and/or facilities at which the Program is located, or (d) the actions or inactions of the entities and persons identified below; and I fully accept and freely assume all such risk and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages I may incur as a result of my participation in the Program.


