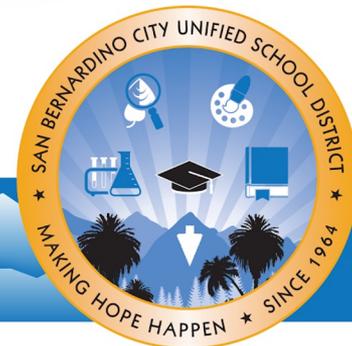

- Middle Schools are allotted 2 CSO's
- Alternative HS, Middle College, Paakuma, Rodriguez and Richardson each have one CSO.
