As a high school junior or senior, you have an opportunity to earn four college credits by taking **NGT 101 - Overview of the Natural Gas & Oil Technology** this fall in an online format.

### Overview of the Natural Gas & Oil Technology

This course is a comprehensive study of the natural gas and oil industry. Topics to be covered include industry sectors; history of natural gas and oil drilling, production, transportation, storage and transmission processes; and environmental topics. Special focus will be on career opportunities in the industry.

### About Online/E Learner Courses

Online courses offer you the opportunity to take a course and learn from any location with an Internet connection. You will log into the online classroom at your convenience; however, your instructor will specify how frequently you are required to log into your online classroom and participate in discussions using the message boards. To be successful, you need to possess maturity and self-discipline.

**Class runs October 22 through December 17, 2014.**

*Deadline to apply is Friday, October 17.*

**Tuition is \$98 per credit for Westmoreland County residents and \$196 for out-of-county residents.**

*Plus, you can apply to receive a minimum scholarship of \$250 toward the course tuition and fees. Additional funding may be available. Seats are limited so early application and acceptance is critical.*

### Requirements

In order to enroll, you must:

1. Be a high school junior or senior with a GPA of 2.5 or better
2. Obtain approval of your high school counselor by completing the WCCC High School Early Enrollment Form available at [wccc.edu/admissions](http://wccc.edu/admissions) or your guidance counselor
