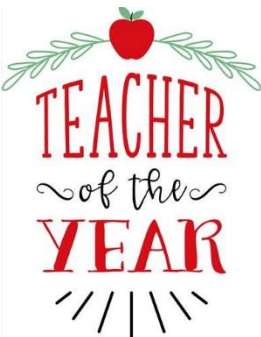
Lost & Found Items

ISDS DIPLOMA INFORMATION

What is the International Skills Diploma Seal (ISDS)?

Offered at Northview since the 2024-2025 school year, the ISDS is a federal initiative that colleges, universities, and businesses recognize. In today's global marketplace, it is important for students to acquire the interdisciplinary skills they need to be globally competent and competitive. The International Skills Diploma Seal is awarded to high school students their senior year who have completed an international education curriculum and have engaged in extracurricular activities and experiences that foster the achievement of global competencies. It serves as a signal to employers and higher education institutions that a student is prepared to participate in the global economy. Students can indicate on their college applications that they are candidates for the ISDS.

REQUIREMENTS:

■ Earn 8 credits in World Language, ESOL, and globally-focused coursework.

Possible combinations include:

3 WL/ESOL + 5 Global Focus

4 WL/ESOL + 4 Global Focus

5 WL/ESOL + 3 Global Focus

■ Participate in at least four extracurricular activities/experiences with global themes or in global contexts, such as travel abroad, exchange programs, or international clubs.

■ Complete 20 hours of community service with a cross-cultural or international focus.

■ Create a Capstone Presentation about your ISDS experience and the knowledge you gained from the courses and activities (completed senior year and presented in front of other candidates as well as a staff committee).
