



EL 2.0 Global Executive Constraint

Policy Quadrant: Executive Limitations

- Monitoring Time Frame: July 1, 2024 - June 30, 2025
- Date of School Board Monitoring: December 8, 2025

Board Policy Monitoring Motions:

- Operational Interpretation is/is not reasonable
- Board does/does not accept the Superintendent's assertion of compliance/non-compliance

Global Constraint:

The Superintendent shall not cause or allow any practice, activity, decision, or organizational circumstance that is unlawful, unethical, imprudent, or in violation of commonly accepted business and professional practices.

OPERATIONAL INTERPRETATION:

I interpret this policy to mean that I shall not permit any District practice, activity, decision, or organizational circumstance that is unlawful, unethical, imprudent, or inconsistent with commonly accepted business and professional practices, within the reasonable and legal scope of District control. Executive Limitations (2.1–2.9) collectively define and ensure that District operations remain lawful, ethical, prudent, and aligned with commonly accepted professional standards providing guardrails in critical operational areas:



- 2.1 Emergency Superintendent Succession
- 2.2 Treatment of Students
- 2.3 Treatment of Parents
- 2.4 Treatment of Staff
- 2.5 Financial Planning and Budgeting
- 2.6 Financial Management and Operations
- 2.7 Asset Protection
- 2.8 Compensation and Benefits
- 2.9 Communication and Support to the School Board

Therefore, compliance with EL 2.1–2.9 constitutes reasonable evidence of compliance with the Global Executive Constraint (EL 2.0).
