Bullskin Township Elementary School School-Parent-Student Compact

The School Parent Compact is a voluntary agreement jointly developed with parents and family members. The compact outlines how parents, the entire school staff, and students will share in the responsibility for improved student academic achievement and the means by which the school and the parents will build and develop partnerships to help children achieve the State's high standards (ESSA, Section 1116(d)). To accomplish the goals set forth in this compact, the Bullskin Township Elementary School community pledges to work together to enable student success.

School

Parents can expect that Bullskin Township Elementary School will provide high quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment for every student. In addition, we will...

1. Address the needs of each individual student by:
 - a. Analyzing standardized test scores which will include: DIBELS, PSSA, CDT testing (grades 3-5) and STAR Math.
 - b. Providing intensive intervention for students who are in need of instructional assistance through the RtII program in grades K-2. In addition, a core intervention is implemented for grades 3-5.
 - c. Providing enrichment opportunities for students who could benefit from such activities through RtII, Project Lead the Way (STEM Based Curriculum 3-5), MakerSpace Library (K-5 STEAM) and Accelerated Reader.

2. Hold parent-teacher conferences to discuss each child's individual progress.
 - a. District conferences will be held during the first semester in November.
 - b. Individual conferences can be scheduled at any time, if needed.
3. Invite parents to attend informational sessions throughout the school year.
 - a. Kindercamp and Orientation are held in August.
 - b. Other Title I events throughout the school year as determined by the survey results.
4. Provide a safe and friendly learning environment.
 - a. Continuation of school-wide PBIS program (Positive Behavior and Intervention Support).
 - b. Conduct monthly fire and safety drills, routine weather drills and crisis drills.
5. Ensure clear and open communication between the school, students, and parents.
 - a. Letters and newsletters sent home on a regular basis; announcements through Powerschool e-mail or classroom teacher's Remind app.
 - b. Planbooks for students in grades 4-5
 - c. Parent Portal routinely updated
 - d. Update the school website to provide parents with information regarding school events.
