- Provide quiet study time at home, encourage good study habits, and complete homework.
- Promote the positive use of the child's extracurricular time.
- Limit television and electronic screen freedom and help select valuable programs and device applications.
- Express high expectations, praise, and encouragement.
- Be a positive role model for my child through my interactions with others.
- Encourage my child to read by reading with them.
- Involve my child in problem-solving situations.
- Make sure my child attends school regularly.
- Talk to my child about their school activities each day.
- Establish a family routine.
- Find out how my child is doing in school by attending conferences, meetings, looking at school work, or calling/emailing the teacher.
- Get involved in my child's education by participating in PTG and school-sponsored activities, volunteering, donating, etc.
- Check in with my child daily about social and emotional concerns.
- Check my child's backpack at the end and beginning of each school day.
- Help to teach responsibility for all electronic and technological devices inside and outside the school.
- Periodically check the school website.
