
The work session was called to order/Instruction for Public Comments: President Warren at 6:00 p.m.

<p>Strategic Plan Update: Student Success Committee (Mary McMaster and Kendra Payette-Linn)</p> <p>In the second year of our district's Strategic Plan, we have continued to strengthen systems and practices across five key areas: Early Childhood, MTSS, STEM, CTE/Postsecondary Readiness, and Social-Emotional Learning (SEL). The focus this year is on data-informed improvement, alignment of supports, and consistency of implementation districtwide.</p> <p>All areas were discussed, showing measurable progress and increased collaboration across the elementary and secondary levels. The district's focus on data use, alignment, and professional growth has led to stronger systems supporting student learning and well-being. Moving into Winter/Spring of 2026, efforts will center on consistency of practice, deeper data analysis, and sustaining the connections between early learning, academic supports, and postsecondary readiness.</p>
