SERVICES OFFERED

- **General Education Inclusion:** Opportunities for supported integration into regular education classes. The LASSO 2 program, allows students to attend and/or gain exposure to academic classes, lunch, art, PE, music, etc. in the mainstream environment as suits their abilities over time.
- **Enrichment Programs:** Adapted PE (as applicable) and Art Therapy weekly support physical, social, and creative growth.
- **Family Communication:** Daily communication (home reports) to keep families informed
- **Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC):** Use of individualized communication devices to support student voice

AT SECTOR

The LASSO 2 program serves students in K-8th grade who demonstrate characteristics of autism. Students benefit from a highly structured and visually supported environment grounded in the principles of structured teaching. Housed within general education school settings, LASSO 2 provides instruction that emphasizes communication, social interaction, behavior regulation, and academic skill development.

The LASSO 2 program has been designed for those students in K-8th grades who exhibit characteristics of Autism. A LASSO 2 student requires a highly structured and visual environment that utilizes the structured teaching methodology.

A LASSO 2 student can be successful in a specialized class that is housed in a general education school building. Instruction in this program focuses on communication, socialization, supported behavior regulation and alternate instruction with mainstreaming opportunities.
