Every member of our team brings a unique story, and those stories help define who we are as a workplace. Here's one of those voices:

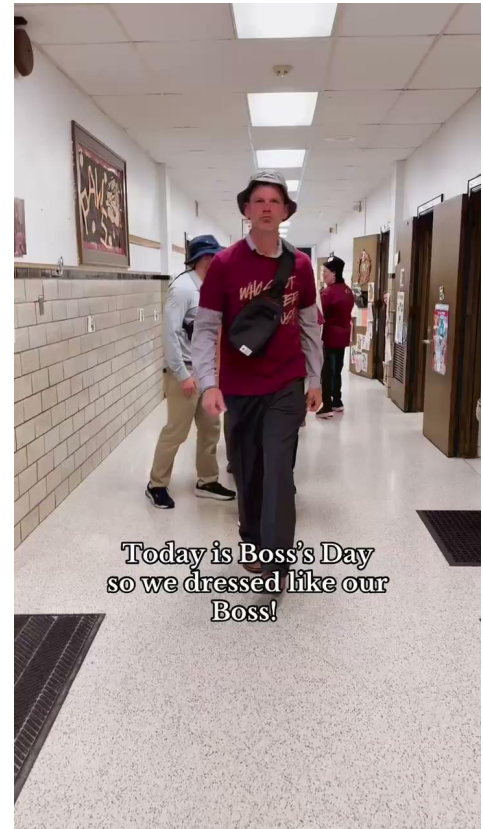
