## 1. Call to Order

## 4. Data Dive

The group reviewed **Progress Monitoring (PM) 1** data and participated in small group discussions to analyze results and trends. Each group compared **Jamerson, District, and State** data in the following areas:

- ELA (Grades 3–5)
- 3rd Grade ELA Categories Tested
- Math and Math Subgroup Data
- Attendance Data (by Male/Female)

Following the review, the group reflected using the “**But, So, Because**” exercise to connect data insights to the School Improvement Plan (SIP) goals.

### Discipline Data

- Discipline data is tracked by subgroup (“Black students” and “Non-Black students”).
- The school’s goal is to **reduce the risk ratio** of our Black students through consistent implementation of **Progressive Discipline, PBIS, and Conscious Discipline**.
- Minor counts **reset each quarter** to ensure fairness and consistency.
- Although Jamerson did not make the PBIS District recognition list this year, the school **completed the Benchmarks of Quality (BOQ) self-assessment** and continues to maintain a strong PBIS system. Feedback received was that we graded ourselves too critically and next year we will focus more on our

strengths in addition to highlighting our areas for growth.

## 5. Culture & Climate Updates (SIP Goal 4)

### Points of Pride

- **Special Visitors:** A bridge engineer and Mayor Ken Welch visited campus.
- **Ms. Tweed** was recognized as a **Pinellas County Schools “It Factor” Teacher**, celebrating her creativity, dedication, and lasting impact on students.

- **Mrs. Bishop** successfully completed the **PCS Certificate of Distinction Program**, recognizing support staff who demonstrate exceptional professional growth and community service.
