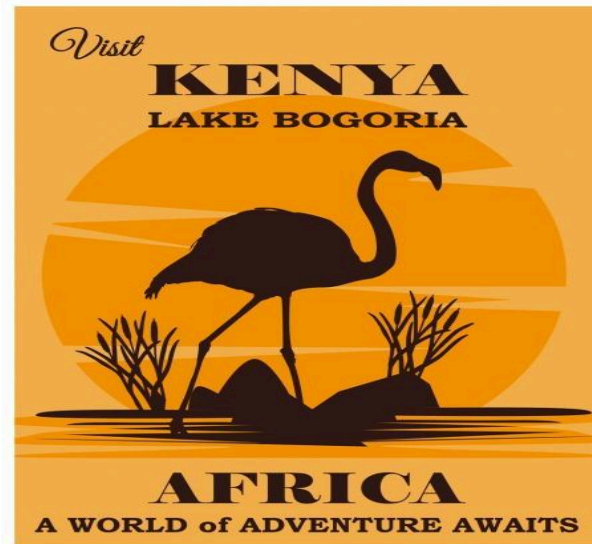


Kenya

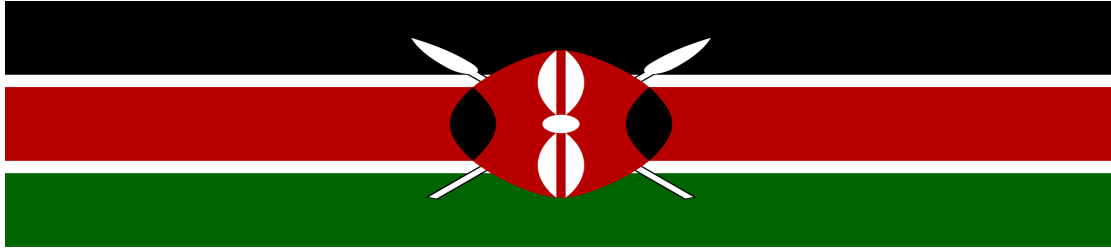
