Purpose:

To provide financial assistance for further education (at a four-year university, junior college, community college, or accredited trade school) to a graduating student at Pearland High School.

Scholarship Award(s):

1. If \$200 or more is available, at least one scholarship will be awarded annually. If more than \$200 is available, the Scholarship Committee will vote on how many scholarships to award and the amount of each scholarship to be awarded during the final Scholarship Committee meeting depending on the number of eligible applicants.
2. Scholarship money will be disbursed on behalf of the student directly to the school in which the student is enrolled and in good standing. The scholarship recipient(s) will receive instructions on how to request scholarship funds. The recipient(s) may choose to receive the entire scholarship award at once or in increments of no less than \$200. The student will have a maximum of two (2) years to request distributions. If any funds remain unclaimed at the end of the second year, the recipient forfeits those remaining funds.

Scholarship Committee:

The committee shall be composed of three (3) or five (5) members of the PTA. The Committee Chairperson will remove all identifying information except the student's School ID from the documents received by the applicants so that the reviewers will judge candidates based on the merit of the documents submitted without bias. After each committee member individually reviews and scores each of the eligible applicants, the Scholarship Committee will meet, discuss the individual ratings, and determine who should receive the scholarship(s). Based on the committee's review as a group, the committee may choose to award scholarships to individuals equally or award more funds to the candidate(s) the committee rated the highest.

Publicity:

The PTA Scholarship will be published through the PHS counselor's office, the PHS PTA Facebook page, and email to PHS PTA members.

Scholarship Eligibility:

In order for a student to be considered by the Scholarship Committee, the following requirements must be met, the student:

1. Or at least 1 parent must be a current PHS PTA member on or before October 31st of the current school year
2. Must have been enrolled at PHS for at least 3 years
3. Must be a graduating senior
4. Must have met school attendance guidelines as stipulated by the State of Texas
5. Must have a current GPA of 2.5 or above based on the transcript published by PHS after the first semester of the current school year

Application Requirements:

The following documents must be submitted in the order listed on or before the Application Deadline.
