Questions from BOE Meeting 7.23.25

- **Glen Cove Police Department** presentation on whether it is best to dial 911 or the 516-676-1000 (discussed with Chief Whitton and Deputy Chief Ortiz on August 5th). Will schedule this presentation in the fall, invite GCPD and share the topic with the community.
- **Swim Program** - we are actively researching this topic to present at a future meeting.
- **Emergency call stations** - we are researching this in consultation with the District's new Security Consultant.

Questions from BOE Meeting 7.23.25



- **Extreme Heat and Half Days**

- 180 days of instruction must be met and a minimum number of hours of instruction.
 - K - 6th grade: 900 hours of instruction.
 - 7th - 12th grade: 990 hours.
 - A half day would count toward one of the total 180 instructional days, but it would count less for the total number of instructional hours for that day.
 - If we close, we always have to ensure that our days and hours are within the minimum that we must meet. Our snow days are calculated to make sure that they would not impact those totals.
-
- If the temperature goes above the threshold of 88F, students will be moved to another location. There is no requirement in the policy to inform families.

 - Our Facilities Dept. installed window AC units in all learning spaces at the four elementary schools that were able to have an AC unit installed using the AC units repurposed from the HS interior curtain wall, plus an additional 8 units that were purchased.

Board of Education Meetings 2025 - 2026

- We attended a Board Retreat to receive guidance from NYSSBA on July 10.
- Board of education meetings are *open to the public* and include agenda items that are open for discussion, reports, and potential votes on school-related matters.
- An executive session is a *portion* of a school board meeting that is *not open to the public*.
- Boards are allowed to enter into an executive session to discuss sensitive topics.
- First, a motion to move into an executive session must be made within the open meeting. The motion should identify the general area(s) or the subject(s) to be considered. The board then votes and an executive session can occur.

- Starting in the 2025-2026 school year, *if there is a need* for an executive session the BOE will convene at the high school auditorium at 6:00pm. The meeting will be called to order, and there will be a vote to move into executive session.
