EARN FREE COLLEGE CREDITS WHILE IN HIGH SCHOOL!

Volusia County Schools and Daytona State College have partnered to provide Career and Technical Education (CTE) students the opportunity to receive college credit toward an A.S. degree or certificate program!

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

High school students enrolled in an approved CTE Career Pathways Program, earn a **B or higher** in each required high school CTE course, and meet DSC admissions requirements.

HOW TO GET CREDIT

Choose ONE of the following: **Option A:** Pass a DSC Credit-by-Exam for courses listed on the Career Pathway or **Option B:** Earn an approved Industry Certification.

VALIDATION REQUIRED

Submit high school transcript and provide industry certification (*if applicable*). Credit must be claimed within 3 years of high school graduation. Student must complete 25% of specific college program for credits to appear.
