Kyrene Long-Range Planning Update

December 10, 2025

The Kyrene Governing Board held a study session on Tuesday, December 9 to review **two alternate proposals** to the Long-Range Planning recommendation, both of which would close fewer schools. In addition to the two alternate proposals, the board also reviewed smaller adjustments to the initial proposal.

Changes to the proposed boundary maps have ripple effects that impact nearly every school in some way. That is why I strongly encourage *all* Kyrene families and staff review the proposals to see how each one impacts your elementary and middle schools' boundaries. The three proposals (including maps, implementation timelines, and an outline of the impact on each school) can be viewed on our website at www.kyrene.org/longrangeplan.

All three proposals will be considered for a possible vote at the governing board meeting on December 16.

As I shared last week, we understand how significantly these discussions impact our families, staff and community, and we remain committed to providing clear and timely information throughout this process. We will begin sharing details about the potential transition once the governing board has made its final decisions.
