Memorial High School is offering essential support to its community through the **Food Pantry and Clothing Closet**, available to MHS students and families

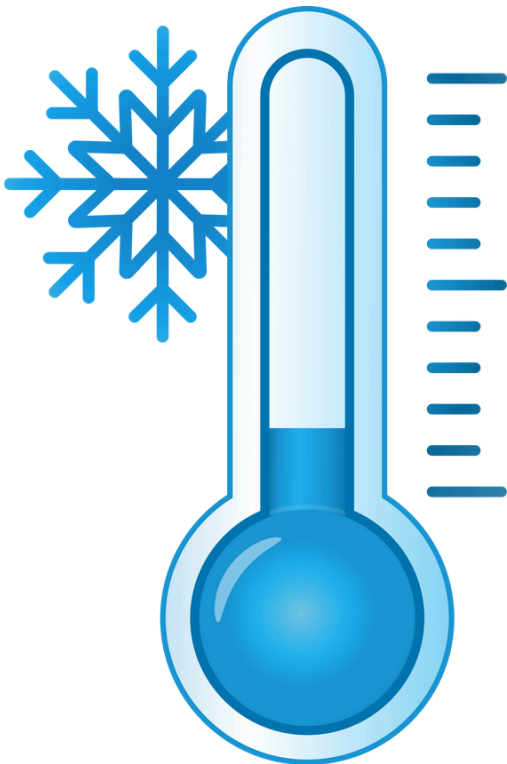
Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2 to 3:15 pm.

There is a familiar chill in the air which leads us to think about colder weather and the inclement weather that may come with it.

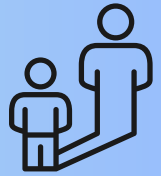
