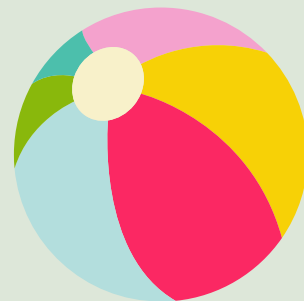

REMINDERS WHEN ABSENT FROM SCHOOL

Whether you miss one day of school, or several, here are some helpful reminders to make sure you don't fall behind:

- Check your Google Classroom pages for each subject – teachers post weekly agendas, homework assignments, videos, links and materials that students can access
- Email your teachers and ask what you can be working on; this shows responsibility
- If you will be out for an extended period of time, have someone in the household call the main office (716) 569-7055 and request work. Teachers will get items together and will leave them at the window of the main office where they can be picked up.
- When you return to school, schedule a time to meet with your teachers to catch up.

 - After School Monday through Thursday in our Academic Accountability Program
