Each week there is a Theme and a thought for the day.



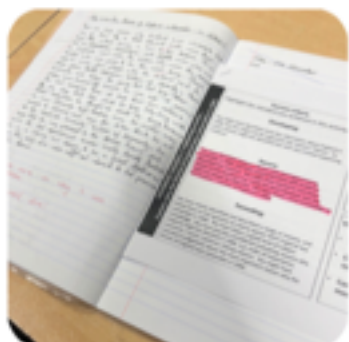

Sixth Form students volunteer their time to do Paired Reading with Year 7 students on a Thursday.



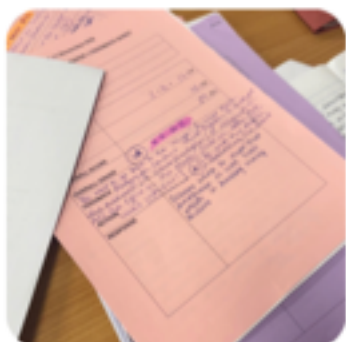
Year 8

Working on developing the complexity of their abstract composition.



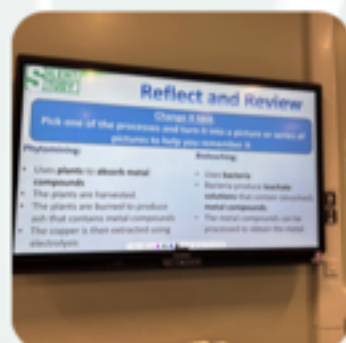
Year 10

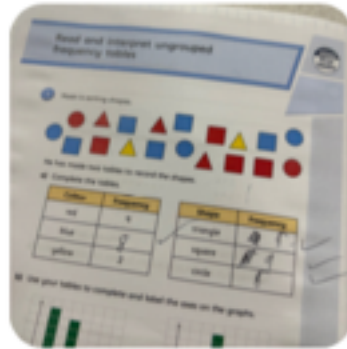
Students were reviewing learning of Phytomining and Bioleaching, after learning about the advantages and disadvantages of each.

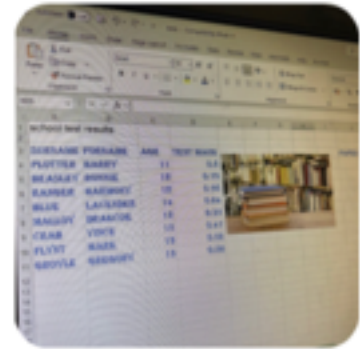
Year 13

Geographers were learning about tropical rainforests and the range of environments in Australia



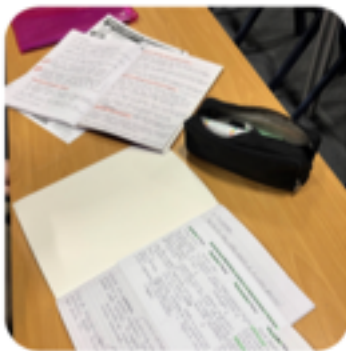
Year 8

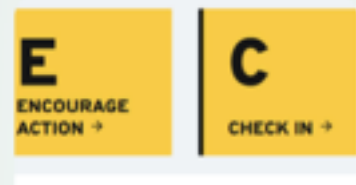
