

Statement from Dulwich College

Dulwich College has featured in recent media reports about alleged behaviour between pupils many decades ago. We understand that such coverage can be distressing, especially for those who have experienced or witnessed discrimination in the past.

The behaviours described are wholly contrary to the culture we uphold today. Dulwich is a diverse, inclusive and compassionate community in which discrimination, prejudice and bullying have no place. Our priority is, and remains, to ensure that every pupil feels safe, respected and supported. We have strong pastoral systems, clear routes for raising concerns, and a sustained focus on equality, diversity and inclusion.

Since the allegations relate to events nearly fifty years ago, the College is unable to confirm or refute them. Our focus is to acknowledge the concern felt within the community and to reaffirm the values and safeguards that define the College today.
