

International Academy Information for 8th Grade Students

8th grade students who are interested in applying to the International Academy for high school may do so by visiting <https://www.iatoday.org/ia-okma/prospective-students-okma>. Applications for the class of 2030 are now being accepted, and the deadline to apply for the lottery is January 25, 2026. All information regarding the IA curriculum, enrollment meeting dates, FAQs, and the lottery application process can be found on the International Academy website. Families that have questions are encouraged to visit the Okma Campus Prospective Students website or contact the IA directly by calling the Okma Campus Enrollment Coordinator at 248-341-5900.

Attendance Reporting Procedure

Please notify the school of any student absences, late arrivals, or early dismissals before 12:00pm on the day of the event.

How to Report Attendance

You have two simple options for reporting a full-day absence or requesting a partial-day change:

Option 1: Online via [ParentVue](#)

1. log into your [ParentVue](#) Account.
2. Click "**Report Absence**" next to your student's name.
3. **Select the correct date(s)**. The system defaults to the current day. You may report for the current day or schedule absences up to one week in advance.
4. In the "**Select a reason**" drop-down, choose "**absent**" for all requests (full-day absence, early dismissal, or late arrival).
5. **For early dismissal or late arrival**, use the "**Note**" section to clearly state the specific time of dismissal or arrival.
6. Remember to press **SAVE** when finished!

Option 2: Telephone

Call the **VH Attendance Line** at **248-726-4910** and follow the prompts to report either an all-day or part-day absence.

Early Dismissal Procedure

If your student is leaving school early:

- The student will be sent a pass from the office to notify them of the scheduled dismissal.
- They should come to the main office at the designated time.
- The student will wait in the office until the parent/guardian arrives in the lobby and signs them out.

A Note From Nurse Tanya

Thank you graciously to families and school communities for the shared partnership in keeping children healthy, happy and safe at school!

When to Keep Children Home Sick from School

Fever

Fever greater than 100.4° F- Return to school when fever free for 24 hrs., without medication.

Unspecified Respiratory

Persistent coughing, congestion, heavy nasal drainage, etc.- Return to school when symptoms have significantly improved or resolved.

Vomiting/ Diarrhea

Episodes alone with any other symptom, or 2 or more episodes with no other symptoms- Return to school when no vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hrs.

Sore/dry throat

Discomfort not relieved by cool sips of water- Cough drops should be reserved for home use and not for school use.

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
