

Énfasis Sugerido: “Ve y dile a Juan lo que has visto y escuchado.”  
 ¡Regocíjense! Jesús es el verdadero Mesías quien trae la sanación y la fuerza al pueblo de Dios.

Perspectiva Salesiana:  
 La promesa de la salvación de Dios es muy específica en las lecturas de ambos, el evangelio de Mateo y el libro del profeta Isaías.

El pueblo de Dios estuvo esperando por mucho tiempo la llegada de ‘aquel’ que los salvaría del pecado. El pueblo de Dios esperó por mucho tiempo la llegada de aquel establecería el convenio de Dios con ellos para siempre. Aun así, habían ciertas preguntas fundamentales que rondaban en la mente de aquellos que por tanto tiempo esperaron esa intervención divina: ¿cuándo vendrá el Mesías? ¿Cómo sabremos que es él cuando aparezca? ¿Cuál será el significado y el tono de su mensaje? ¿Cuáles serán las señales que debemos tener presentes?

La respuesta de Jesús es clara e inequívoca: él enumera las señales que anunciarán la llegada del Salvador tan esperado.

El Mesías, que es Jesús, pasó su vida redimiendo – no condenando – al pueblo de Dios. Los símbolos del ministerio de Jesús fueron la esperanza y la sanación. La fuente del mensaje liberador de Cristo era el poder y la promesa del amor redentor de Dios.

El adviento nos recuerda que Dios cumple las promesas que hace. La temporada del adviento nos recuerda las señales del amor liberador, redentor y transformador de Dios que continúan manifestándose hasta nuestros días. La temporada del adviento nos recuerda nuestra propia necesidad de reformar – de hacer que nuestros corazones cambien- para que así podamos llegar a conocer el poder de la esperanza a la cual todos hemos sido llamados.

San Francisco de Sales escribió: “Quién se atreverá a dudar ahora de la cantidad de medios que tenemos a nuestra disposición para obtener la salvación, gracias a nuestro gran Salvador, a imagen de quien hemos sido creados y por cuyos méritos hemos sido rescatados?” (Tratado del Amor de Dios, Libro II, Capítulo 5) Aun así, este gran regalo nos llega acompañado de una gran responsabilidad. San Francisco de Sales es enfático en decir que Dios trabaja en todos y cada uno de los corazones humanos. Por eso mismo, como cristianos que somos y que ‘vivimos en el mundo’ debemos reconocer que nuestras relaciones con los demás son una parte integral del plan continuo de salvación de Dios. Desde la perspectiva del “Santo Caballero,” la temporada del adviento nos reta a hacernos ciertas que deben ser fundamentales para nosotros: ¿somos símbolos convincentes de la presencia del Mesías? ¿Somos símbolos del amor redentor y transformador de Dios? ¿Somos fuentes de la esperanza y de la sanación en las vidas de los demás?

Muchos de nosotros vamos a invertir mucho tiempo y energía decorando nuestros hogares y nuestros barrios para celebrar el milagro del nacimiento de Cristo, la manifestación del poder y la promesa de la encarnación del amor de Dios; un amor personificado en la vida, el ministerio y el mensaje de Jesucristo. ¿Qué tan deliberadamente y tan conscientemente decoraremos nuestras vidas con esas virtudes que hablan de la presencia del Mesías en nuestras relaciones con los demás? ¿Cuándo nos cruzamos con otras personas, pueden ellos “ver y escuchar” las señales del Mesías?

**AVOIDING HOLIDAY SCAMS THIS SEASON –**

The holiday season is a time for spreading joy and generosity. Unfortunately, it's also a popular time of year for scammers to exploit your goodwill and steal your money, gifts, or personal information. Staying alert and informed can help you protect yourself from falling victim to these schemes. Here are a few.

*Gift card scams:* Gift cards are a popular and convenient gift option, but they can also be a target for scammers. Some of them tamper with gift cards on display racks by removing the film strip, recording the card and PIN numbers, resealing the packaging, and placing the card back on the shelf. Once the card is purchased and activated, their computer program alerts them, allowing them to drain the card's funds, leaving you with a worthless gift card. Protect yourself by buying gift cards from secure locations, such as behind the counter at a store. Choose to send e-gift cards directly to recipients through reputable websites.

*Counterfeit Goods Scams:* While browsing online or scrolling social media, you might come across luxury items or brand-name goods at unbelievably low prices. These deals are often scams. In some cases, the seller takes your money but never delivers the item. In others, they send counterfeit, low-quality versions of the advertised products. Watch for red flags such as prices that seem too good to be true; requests for unusual payment methods like wire transfers, gift cards, or cryptocurrency, and limited information about the seller,

such as no return policy or lack of contact details. Shop only at trusted retailers and check customer reviews. Make sure the seller has clear refund and return policies. If you think you've been scammed, report it to the FTC ReportFraud.ftc.gov or call 1.877.382.4357.

*Delivery Scams:* Delivery scams are common during the holidays. Scammers send phishing emails or text messages posing as trusted delivery services like UPS, FedEx, or the U.S. Postal Service. These fraudulent messages usually claim you have an incoming or missed delivery and include links designed to infect your device with malware or steal your personal information. Don't click on links in suspicious emails or texts. Double-check delivery notifications by visiting the delivery service's official website and entering your tracking information.

*Charitable Giving Scams:* The holidays inspire charitable giving, but scammers take advantage of this goodwill by creating fake charities to steal your donations. They may contact you through unsolicited phone calls, emails, or social media posts. Don't answer calls from unknown numbers or click on links in unsolicited emails. Research a charity before donating to ensure it's legitimate. You can verify charities on websites like Give.org, CharityWatch.org, or CharityNavigator.org. Only donate by credit card or check. Charities that ask for payment via wire transfers, gift cards, or cryptocurrency are likely scams.

*Package Theft Prevention:* Package thefts spike during the holiday season,

although they're not technically scams. Taking steps to secure your deliveries can prevent valuables from being stolen from your porch. Choose to have packages delivered to a secure drop box or locker when possible. Request a signature for high-value items. Install a doorbell camera to monitor deliveries. It can notify you when packages arrive so you can bring them inside quickly or ask a neighbor to retrieve them if you're away.

Yes, there are more scams out there, but these are the ones that spike in the holiday season. Stay on top of them and protect yourself. Google Silver Shield Anti-Scam Program for additional information.

The Fairfax County Sheriff's Office is also warning residents about an increase in scam calls. In these cases, callers falsely identify themselves as deputies or other representatives of the Sheriff's Office. They claim there's an arrest warrant for the person and demand payment to resolve the matter. The Sheriff's Office will never call and demand money, gift cards, or electronic payment to clear a warrant. Never provide personal or financial information. If you receive one of these calls or fall victim to the scam, email the Fairfax County Sheriff's Office, [SHF-Sheriff@fairfaxcounty.gov](mailto:SHF-Sheriff@fairfaxcounty.gov). Sheriff Kincaide commented, "The best defense is awareness. By sharing information, sharing your stories with family, friends, and neighbors, you can help prevent more people from being victimized."
