StopIt is an **anonymous reporting platform**—empowering students to safely report concerns and help prevent potential threats.

Whether they've witnessed something concerning or know someone who may be in danger, students can use **StopIt** to submit tips anonymously—anytime, anywhere.

This program provides schools with a direct, secure channel to surface threats early and coordinate a timely response. In partnership with **Lightspeed Systems**, StopIt is designed to support school safety teams by streamlining how reports are received, assessed, and acted on—following best practices in threat detection, behavioral risk assessment, and crisis prevention.

StopIt Helps Schools Respond to Concerns Early



Submit a Tip

When students are worried about a peer or notice something unsafe—like bullying, threats, weapons, or self-harm—they can use StopIt to submit an anonymous tip. Reports go directly to your school's safety team so concerns can be reviewed and addressed quickly.



Crisis Text Line

Students can connect with a trained mental health counselor—confidential, free, and available 24/7 through Crisis Text Line.
