BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Education Code Sections 32280-32289 establishes that each school district is responsible for the overall development of all comprehensive school safety plans for its schools operating kindergarten or any of grades 1 to 12. A safety plan has also been submitted for the Child Development Center (CDC). Each school including the CDC, shall review, update, and adopt its comprehensive school safety plan by March 1st of each school year.

In order to ensure compliance with the article, each school, including the CDC shall forward its comprehensive school safety plan to the District for approval.
