Namibia's size and size is 824,292 square km. Its population is 3.02 to 3.18 million people. Namibia's name was adopted by the United Nations in 1968, the name was chosen from a desert called Namib Desert. Namibia is located in the Southern part of Africa. Namibia's capital is Windhoek.

Namibia's tallest mountain is Brandberg Mountain, also known as Konigstein. It's height is 2,573 m. Namibia's longest river is the Fish river. It is about 400 miles! Namibia's largest city is its capital, Windhoek. Namibia does not have states, but it has 14 administrative regions. Namibia is located in Africa. Its neighboring countries are Angola to the North, Zambia to the Northeast, Botswana to the East, South Africa to the South, and the Atlantic Ocean to the West.

Namibia's president is a woman Netumbo Nandi-Ndaitwah. She's the first female president of Namibia.

The Namibia flag has 5 colors: Blue; representing the sky, Atlantic Ocean, and the country's water. Red; Namibia's people, and determination for equality. White; peace and unity. Green; Namibia's rich vegetation and agricultural resources. Yellow sun; life, energy, and hope for the future.

Some historical facts about Namibia are that Namibia gained independence in 1990. To decide the symbols for the flag, the National Symbols sub-committee organized a nationwide competition.

Namibia's famous people are Sam Nujoma, Hage Geingob, etc. Namibia's religion is mostly Lutheran. The official language of Namibia is English. The food that the people eat in Namibia is Braai, Pap, Kapana, and oysters. The clothes they wear are Ovambo, Nama, and San. The music they listen to
