Application Procedures:

Please fill out one application per student. Applications are being accepted for limited enrollment in Learning Options Alternative High School for 9th - 12th grades for the 2nd semester of the 2025-2026 school year. Applications must be submitted by the parent/guardian (if student is under 18 years) or by the student (if over 18 years). **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Current high school transcript
- Two school years Behavior Report from previous school(s) with school administrator's signature is required with this application.
- Students with an IEP are required to provide most current copy of IEP and MET with this application.

Application Rules:

1. The buildings available for Schools-of-Choice students and the number of spaces in each building will be determined by Lake Orion Community Schools.
2. All applications will be screened for accurate information. This may involve contacting your current school district.
3. Your acceptance is conditional until Lake Orion Community Schools receives and reviews all school reports.
4. If accepted, Lake Orion Community Schools' enrollment process must be completed by **Friday, Jan. 16, 2026**. If students are not enrolled by that date, Lake Orion Community Schools will assume that your application for Schools-of-Choice has been withdrawn and the position will be offered to the next eligible student.
5. (A) *If your child is currently eligible for special education programs and services, and you reside outside of Oakland County, please be aware that Lake Orion Community Schools is required to secure a "Cooperative Agreement" regarding reimbursement for special education costs from your resident district before we can register your child in our school district.*
6. (B) *If you reside outside of Oakland County and your child is found to be eligible for special education programs and services after admission to Lake Orion Community Schools, please be advised that the district is required to obtain a "Cooperative Agreement" regarding reimbursement for special education costs from your resident district for your child to remain in our school district. (MCL 388.1705c) (19)*
7. Once enrolled in a Schools-of-Choice program, students may remain in the Schools of Choice program of which they are enrolled, until graduation, if the student complies with all guidelines for Schools-of-Choice and Lake Orion Community Schools' "Code of Conduct." The only exception is cited in 6(B) above. **If the contact information on your application changes (phone #'s, email and mailing address) after you have submitted your application it is your responsibility to notify Central Enrollment of these changes.**

Attendance: Students are expected to arrive and depart from school on time. Students who are excessively absent or tardy may be asked to return to their home district. It is expected that parents will pick up students on time when they are attending an after school or evening event.

Code of Conduct: All student "Code of Conduct" rules, procedures, and policies will apply to all students who enter Lake Orion Community Schools under the Schools-of-Choice guidelines and procedures.

Transportation: Parents/Guardians of Schools-of-Choice students are required to provide transportation to and from school.
