
What it measures:

### PROGRESS (30%)


What it measures:  
The amount of growth students are making over time in:

- ELA and Math (measured via Student Growth Percentiles)
- English Language Learners' progress in language acquisition (ACCESS test)

Why it matters:

Even if students aren't yet proficient, strong growth shows they're on track to succeed.

### CLOSING THE GAP (10%)

What it measures:


Whether schools are meeting improvement targets for historically underserved student groups:

- Economically disadvantaged students
- Students with disabilities
- Black, Hispanic, and other minority populations

Why it matters:

This focuses on equity, ensuring that all students make gains—not just some.

### READINESS (15%)

What it measures:


A broader picture of student preparedness, including:

- Student attendance
- Accelerated Enrollment
- Pathway Completion
- College and career readiness indicators

Why it matters:

This reflects how well students are being prepared for life after high school—college, careers, and beyond.

### GRAD RATE (15%)

What it measures:

The percentage of students who graduate in:

- 4 years (standard graduation rate)
- 5 years (extended graduation rate, if used)

Why it matters:

This is the ultimate lagging indicator of school effectiveness—are students completing high school?
