GENERAL TEACHING DUTIES:

2. PHYSICAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT: Promotes physical and mental health in order to facilitate the learning processes and bring about maximum student development.
3. CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT: Helps develop governing forces within students so that they may become constructive members of a free, democratic society.
4. CLASSROOM ORGANIZATION: Organizes the classroom to promote the maximum growth of the individual student.
5. TECHNIQUES OF INSTRUCTION: Provides for each student's interests, needs and abilities, applying instructional techniques which encourage learning commensurate with each student's potential.
