1. ARRIVE ON TIME

**PLEASE ARRIVE AT YOUR SCHEDULED APPOINTMENT SO EVERY FAMILY RECEIVES THE
TIME THEY NEED.**

2. BRING QUESTIONS

**CONSIDER ASKING ABOUT STRENGTHS, GROWTH AREAS, ATTENDANCE, BEHAVIOR,
NOTES, CLASSWORK, AND HOW TO
SUPPORT LEARNING AT HOME.**

3. REVIEW GRADES BEFORE THE MEETING

**CHECK POWERSCHOOL AND DEAN'S LIST FOR CURRENT GRADES, MISSING
ASSIGNMENTS, BEHAVIOR NOTES, AND
ATTENDANCE TRENDS.**

4. SHARE WHAT YOU SEE AT HOME

**LET TEACHERS KNOW ABOUT HOMEWORK HABITS, MOTIVATION, CONCERNS, OR
CHANGES IN BEHAVIOR.**

5. TAKE NOTES DURING THE CONFERENCE

WRITE DOWN RECOMMENDATIONS, GOALS, IMPORTANT DATES, AND ACTION STEPS.

6. ASK ABOUT CLEAR NEXT STEPS

**END THE MEETING WITH A PLAN THAT INCLUDES TEACHER ACTIONS, STUDENT
EXPECTATIONS, AND FAMILY SUPPORT.**

7. STAY POSITIVE AND FOCUSED ON GROWTH

THE GOAL IS THE SAME FOR EVERYONE: YOUR CHILD'S SUCCESS.

8. FOLLOW UP AFTER THE CONFERENCE

**TALK WITH YOUR CHILD ABOUT WHAT WAS DISCUSSED AND HELP THEM STAY ON



ATTENDANCE

Regular school attendance is essential for your child's academic success. Please remember:

- Call the school if your child is absent and/or send a note when they return.
- 10 days absent in a row with no parent contact = student dropped.
- 3 days absent in a row = doctor's note required.
- No pick-ups after 3:00 PM.
- Only listed adults with ID can pick up students.
- Only adults 21+ can pick up early. No exceptions.
- Early, frequent pick-ups hurt grades; may lead to attendance contract and losing spot.

CELL PHONES/ELECTRONICS



Students may not have cell phones, headphones, earbuds, iPads, or electronic games during school hours.

All cell phones must be turned off and stored in the assigned cell phone locker (not hallway lockers) at the start of the day.

If a student is seen or heard with any electronic device, it will be taken and consequences will be given immediately.
