- Take the Pre-ACT
- Attend small-group meetings with college counselor (December)
- Take advantage of opportunities to visit colleges and attend college rep lunch visits
- Plan a meaningful summer experience

SOPHOMORE YEAR

- Work to maintain a balance between academics and extracurricular activities
- Look for ways to engage deeper in activities you enjoy
- Log activities and accomplishments monthly in Scoir
- Attend the Sophomore College Counseling Workshop (September)
- Take PSAT and PreACT
- Attend Sophomore College Night (November)
- Attend small-group meetings with college counselor to review transcripts and discuss activities and test scores
- Take advantage of opportunities to visit colleges and attend college rep lunch visits
- Plan a meaningful summer experience
- Consider the Capstone career exploration experience

JUNIOR YEAR

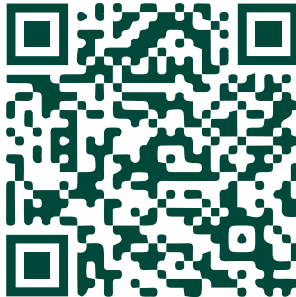
- Work to maintain a balance between academics and extracurricular activities
- Attend the Junior College Counseling Workshop (September)
- Take the PSAT/NMSQT and PreACT
- Complete the Junior College Questionnaire (December)
- Attend Junior College Night (January)
- Schedule Individual College Counseling meeting
- Prepare for ACT/SAT

- Find ways to engage deeply in your favorite activities and extracurriculars (run for office, chair events, etc.)
- Update Scoir's Activity Tracker monthly with activities and accomplishments
- Take advantage of opportunities to visit colleges and attend college rep lunch visits
- Narrow down college list
- Plan a meaningful summer experience
- Consider the Capstone career exploration experience
- Ask teachers for letters of recommendation (April)
- Draft resume
- Write college essays

SENIOR YEAR

- Schedule an Individual College Conference with college counselor to activate Common App account and create college admissions email
- Final resume (August)
- Edit college essay (September)
- Complete Common App application (October)
- Continue testing SAT/ACT
- Attend Senior College Night (September)
- Visit colleges on your college list and attend college rep lunch visits
- Attend College Financial Aid Night (October)
- Complete applications (September-February)
- Activate admissions portals (September-February)
- Await college decisions (September-April)
- Apply for scholarships
- Attend open houses and admitted student days to finalize college decisions
- Select college and pay deposit and enroll (no later than May 1st)
- Schedule your Orientation session at the college you have decided to attend
- Graduation!
